

American Neurotology Society Diversity and Inclusion Committee Under-Represented in Medicine in Otology/Neurotology Travel Scholarship

The American Neurotology Society values diversity in the educational and clinical environment of otology and neurotology and recognize that in order to keep pace with our changing societal demographics and provide culturally sensitive and high-quality care, we must increase the ranks of scientists and clinicians from under-represented minorities in our field. Through this scholarship, we seek to engage URIM students in research and clinical activities related to the ear, hearing and balance so that they can learn about our field and gain the experience needed to promote an interest in a career in otology/neurotology. The successful applicant will receive a \$2000 scholarship to support travel and housing expenses for a chosen research or clinical rotation that requires significant travel from their home institution. A member of the ANS will be identified to provide mentorship and sponsorship to the recipient.

SUBMISSIONS DUE: JUNE 1

REQUIREMENTS:

- Current medical student in M3/M4 year in good standing at LCME approved US and Canadian medical school. (We will also consider M1/M2 residents seeking research rotations.)
- Applicant identifies with a group that is under-represented in medicine as defined by the AAMC (https://www.aamc.org/what-we-do/diversity-inclusion/underrepresented-in-medicine)
- Student cannot combine this award with other Otolaryngology URiM awards for the same rotation.
- Applicant meets VSLO (Visiting Student Learning Opportunities, formerly VSAS) requirements per the rotation institution.
- We require an email confirmation from the clerkship director to the Chair of the ANS Diversity and Inclusion Committee that the rotation was approved.
- We require the recipient prepare a short essay about their experience following the rotation that may be used in the
 ANS communications, due one month after completion of the rotation, emailed to the ANS administrator and the Chair
 of the Diversity and Inclusion Committee.
- Scholarship funds will be disbursed before the start of the chosen rotation.

TO APPLY, SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING IN ONE PDF DOCUMENT:

- Current Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Transcript or Letter of Good Standing from your medical school
- Documentation of approval for rotation at the rotation institution
- Current photo
- Personal statement Please include a description of your personal story, educational background, current educational setting, goals for the away rotation and career interests.
- Letter of recommendation from a faculty member (Does not need to be an otolaryngologist or member of ANS.)
