In addition to inheriting a busy clinical practice, the successful applicant will serve as a core faculty member in our ACGME-accredited Otolaryngology residency training program that began in July 2019 and will receive an academic teaching appointment through the Cooper Medical School at Rowan University, commensurate with level of experience. There are numerous research opportunities, with ample support from medical students & residents, as well as the Department of Surgery.
