Operative experience (text for fellowship to enter): This is a high-volume skull base program that not only includes acoustic neuroma experience but also experience with meningiomas, auditory brainstem implants, and cerebrovascular pathology (e.g., brainstem cavernomas and basilar artery aneurysms)

Call requirements: No in-house call but patient is on backup call to residents; one 24 hour period off each week

Research: Required (1 day/week of assigned research time); expect oral and poster presentations as well as article submissions

Benefits: Health insurance, 3 weeks of vacation, and \$2500 of educational funds

Salary: \$70,000 for 1st year of fellowship and \$75,000 for the 2nd year
