Operative experience (text for fellowship to enter): The University of Southern California/LAC+USC Medical Center Neurotology Fellowship Program is a two-year ACGME-accredited educational program relating to the diagnosis and management of disorders of the temporal bone, lateral skull base, and related anatomical structures, as well as advanced diagnostic expertise and advanced medical and surgical management skills beyond those attained in otolaryngology – head and neck surgery residency. The fellowship ensures that concentrated time is available for the neurotology fellows to develop advanced diagnostic expertise and advanced medical and surgical management skills for the care of diseases and disorders of the petrous apex, infratemporal fossa, internal auditory canals, cranial nerves, and lateral skull base, including the occipital bone, sphenoid bone and temporal bone.
