Wichita Ear Clinic was established in 1892 and is a physician owned Otolaryngology, Neurotology, and Cochlear Implant Center. We are seeking a BE/BC Otolaryngologist/Neurotologist to join our practice. The new physician will be able to start a busy established clinical and surgical practice since one of our physicians has recently retired.

Wichita Ear Clinic provides complete state of the art otology and neurotology patient care. We currently have one neurotologist, nurse practitioner, four audiologists, and a speech pathologist on site. We provide full audiology and vestibular testing, and hearing aid services. We are a busy cochlear implant center with on-site programming and rehabilitation. Our working relationship with our neurosurgical colleagues is excellent and our physicians perform both microsurgical resection and stereotactic radiotherapy for cranial base tumors.

It is an exciting time for medicine in Wichita. The city has approved a 470,000 square foot Health Sciences Center in the heart of Wichita. This Biomedical facility will combine the Wichita campuses of KU School of Medicine and KU School of Pharmacy and Wichita State University's College of Health Professions and WSU Tech's Health Professions Program into one location. The campus is expected to be completed in 2026 and will have an estimated 3000 students and 200 faculty. This will provide additional teaching and research collaboration opportunities for our physicians.

Academic appointment with Kansas University School of Medicine-Wichita is available. Our practice frequently has both KU-Wichita medical and Wichita State University audiology students join us for clinical rotations. Starting in 2024 we will also have students from Kansas College of Osteopathic Medicine join us for clinical rotations.

This position is a unique opportunity to join a well-established single specialty practice. Our practice has full benefits, profit sharing/retirement plan, and excellent hours. Wichita is a growing city and an excellent place to raise a family. We do not have general otolaryngology call responsibilities, and our on-call hours are light.
